

Rank of a Captain or Commanding Officer of some one of the Ships of War of the said Fleet or of some Officer of higher Rank or of some principal Officer in the American Army after said of such delivery, then such Bond to be void else of full force, and the Captain of the said Schooner also making Oath before the naval Officer who shall clear out the said vessel, at or before the time of her clearing out that he will use his utmost endeavours to prevent the said Cargo or any part thereof falling into the hands of the Enemy and will deliver the same if in his power agreeably to this Decree.

James Murray two quire Cartage papers to secure the medicines in the State Shop and also to Capt William Middleton of the Dolphin in the Service of the Continent transporting the Detachment of Troops under the Command of the Marquis La Fayette thirty pound Cannon & six pound Staff pieces.

Monday 12 March 1781.

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Archibald Johnson of the 1st Regiment one suit of cloaths and two shirts Edward Timms of the same Regiment two shirts and one pair of shoes — John Gorman of the same Regiment and John Lindfield ditto, each one shirt and one pair of Breeches — William Roberts of the same Regiment one shirt and one pair of shoes — Peter Byall of the same Regiment one pair of Breeches, William Broton of the 6th Regiment one pair Breeches & one shirt — William Browning of the 2nd Regiment one shirt, and also to Capt Edward Prall of the 1st Regiment one suit of cloaths and Linen for two shirts in part of the Articles for the present year. —

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Hannah May one pound seven Shillings and six pence of the new Emission due her per Acct. passed by the Depts and

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Edward Prall Twenty two pounds eight Shillings and ten pence half penny of the same Emission due him per Account passed by the Depts and —

That the said Treasurer pay to Elizabeth Yeabell two pounds fourteen Shillings and seven pence half penny of the same Emission due her per Account passed by the Depts and —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Gaspaway one hundred and fifty Pounds of the same Emission on Account of his Salary. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Johnson six hundred Shillings and three pence of the same Emission due him per Acct. passed by the D. Aud. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct. Nathan Brownson Purveyor General of the Hospitals of the Southern Department, one hundred Pounds, two hundred Pounds three hundred pounds and four hundred pounds in part of an Order drawn in his favor by Major Genl. Green Commander in Chief in the Southern Department for two thousand pounds Spent agreeable to a Resolution of Congress of June last. —

That the Printing Commissary deliver to the said Doct. Nathan Brownson six Boxes of Spanish Sugar for the use of his Department to be charged the U States taking a Receipt for the Quantity which is to be lodged with this Board.
