That the said Treasurer pay to Philemon Warfields fifteen pounds three shillings and nine pence of the same Emission due him per Act passed by the a^d. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Christopher Richmond of the 1st Regim^t eleven pounds, twelve shillings and one penny half penny of the same Emission due him for Stores per Act passed by the s^d a^d. —

Permission given to William Smith Esq^r of this State to take with him Edward Rouns and John Stevenson the Judges of Henry & John Stevenson now in the City of New York and to solicit Leave from His Excellency General Washington or the Commanding Officer at the out posts of the American Army at Elizabeth Town for the said Edward Rouns & John Stevenson to go into the City of New York. —
