the 2^d Regmt six pounds, eight Shillings and three pence of the same Emission
due him for Stores per account passed by the D. Aud. —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Wheterost eighteen
pounds, fifteen Shillings of the same Emission due him per the paper passed by the D. Aud.

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Capt Benja^a Price eight
Gallons of Rum and thirty two pounds of Sugar due him to Toby inclusive —

That the said Treasurer pay to Ignatius Wheeler two hundred
and eighty two pounds, one Shilling and seven pence of the same Emission due
him per account passed by the aud. Genl. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Hullet of the 7th
Regmt Ten Shillings of the same Emission value of Twenty pounds the Gratt
allowed him by the Genl. Assembly. —

Capt Montjoy Bayly is appointed to receive and provide for
such Recruits as may be raised in Frederick County. —
