Commissions issued to Joseph Chaplin appointed Capt. James Chapman  
Lieut and Thomas Brampton Ensign also to Adam Ott Lieut. Nicholas Hoch  
Lieut and John Lumpkin Ensign of the Select Militia raised in Washington County  
and also to John Hyer second Lieut of Capt John Funk's Company in the same  
Battalion of Militia in the County aforesaid and also to George Hunter Capt  
Thomas Elliott first Lieut and David Stoddart second Lieut of a Company of Artillery  
formed for the Defense of the Harbour of Baltimore -

Rum and thirty two pounds of Sugar - Capt John Mitchell of the 1<sup>st</sup> Regt -  
twelve Gallons of Rum & twenty four pounds of Sugar & also to Capt Charles  
McGallister six Gallons of Rum & twenty four pounds of Sugar, due them  
to the first instant -

That the waster whose Treasurer pay to Capt Horatio Flaget thirty three  
pounds, twelve shillings & nine pence of the new Emision due him & Col<sup>r</sup> paid by the Adj<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>r</sup> -
