That the said Treasurer pay to James Boyle one hundred & five pounds, fifteen shillings and ten pence half penny due him per Account passed by the sd. G<sup>l</sup>. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Thomas Landale of the 4<sup>th</sup> Regimt eleven pounds, four shillings and six pence due him per Account passed by the sd. G<sup>l</sup>. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Ensign John Seaw of the 2<sup>d</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> nine pounds and six pence three farthings due him per Account passed by the sd. G<sup>l</sup>. -

That the Young Commissary deliver to Capt Tho. Landale fourteen Gallons of Rum & fifty six pounds of Sugar due him to this Instant and also to Ensign John Seaw, ten Gallons of Rum & forty pounds of Sugar due him to the 1<sup>st</sup> Instant -

That the Commissary of Store deliver to Capt Thomas Landale Cloth and Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths & Linen for two Shirts in part of the Articles allowed by the General Assembly for the present year.

That Capt George Keports deliver to John D. Thompson Esq. Lieut of Kent County one Barrel Musket powder, Two hundred flints and one hundred Cartridge Boxes on Account.

Monday 9<sup>th</sup> April 1701. -

Ordered that Capt Philomen Warfield deliver to John Turnbull one hundred and fifty Stand of Arms with Accoutrements & one hundred and twenty spare Cartridge Boxes to be delivered over to Col. Joshua Beall. Seventy six Stand with Accoutrements to the Lieut of Charles County and also the further number of Fifty Stand of Arms with Accoutrements, one Barrel of Cannon & one Keg of Musket powder to be by him delivered over to Col. Joshua Beall of Prince Georges County to be by him forwarded to Col. John Musrook Lieut of Montgomery County for the use of the Militia of said County -

That the western shore Treasurer pay to William Lee twenty eight pounds per Account passed by the sd. G<sup>l</sup>. -

That the said Treasurer pay to William McBryde Com<sup>ty</sup> of Purchaser for Somerset County six hundred pounds on Account. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Steele forty four pounds six shillings and six pence due him per Account passed by the sd. G<sup>l</sup>. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Thomas Johnson fifty two pounds, two shillings and six pence due W<sup>m</sup> Johnson and also one hundred and eighty pounds due himself per Account passed by the sd. G<sup>l</sup>. -
