Ordered that Capt. Philemon Harford deliver to John Allen Thomas Ensign one hundred stand of Arms with Ammunition complete and two quarter Casks of Musket powder to be delivered over to Capt. Richard Barnes Lieutenant of St. Mary's County and also twenty five Muskets with Accoutrements complete, two quarter Casks of Musket powder, five hundred Gunflints and two quins of Cartridge paper for the Lieut. of Charles County for the use of the Militia of said Counties. -

That the Amourer deliver to the said John Allen Thomas, five hundred Gunflints five quins of cartridge paper and all the cartridge Boxes to be delivered over to Richard Barnes for the use aforesaid. -

That Christopher Edelin Esq. Collector of the Tax for Prince George County pay to Capt. James Wood Three hundred and Twenty Five Dollars of the new Emission agreeable to a Resolution of Congress of the 26th instant to be charged to the United States, and also to George Murdoch Commissary of Provisions for the Convention Troops one hundred pounds to be by him accounted for. -

That the Western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt. Miles Rawlings one hundred and fifty Dollars for the use of Capt. John Reed, and also the further sum of two hundred Dollars on account. -

Wednesday 11th April 1781.

Ordered that the Amourer deliver to Charles Hatchett forty Gun Locks to be delivered over to William Bradley Esq. Lieut of Kent County and also to Capt. Wams fifty pounds of Lead, one quarter Cask of powder & one quin of cartridge paper for the use of the Militia of Anne Arundel County. -

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Daniel Morris thirty six pounds, thirteen shillings one penny due him per Act. passed by the Comd. Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker eleven pounds, five shillings due him per Account paid by the Comd. Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Job Fowler Messenger to the Govr. & Council thirty one pounds five shillings on account of his Salary. -
