Thomas Esquire one hundred Stands of Arms with Accoutrements complete and
two quarter Sacks of Musket powder to be delivered over to Capt Richard Barnes
Lieutenant of St. Marys County and also twenty five Muskets with Accoutrements
complete, two quarter Sacks of Musket powder, five hundred Gunflints and
two quires of Cartridge paper for the Lieut of Charles County for the use of the
Militia of said Counties. -

That the Armourer deliver to the said John Allen Thomas, five
hundred Gunflints, five quires of Cartridge paper and all the Cartridge Boxes to be
delivered over to Richard Barnes for the use aforesaid. -

That Christopher Edelm Esq. Collector of the Tax for District
County pay to Capt James Wood three hundred and seventy five Dollars of the new
Emission agreeable to a Resolution of Congress of the 26th June to be charged
to the United States, and also to George Sturdock Commissary of Provisions for
the Convention Troops one hundred pounds to be by him accounted for. -

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt Major Rawlings
one hundred and fifty Dollars for the use of Capt John Rice, and also the
further sum of two hundred Dollars on Account. -

Ordered that the Armourer deliver to Charles Harkett forty Gun
Locks to be delivered over to William Baidley Esq. Lieut of Kent County and also to
Capt. Weems fifty pounds of Lead, one quarter Sack of powder & one quire of Cartridge
paper for the use of the Militia of Ann Arundel County. -

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Daniel Munno thirty
five pounds, thirteen shillings and one penny due him paid paper by the Aud. G^l. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker eleven pounds, five
shillings due him per Account paper by the Aud. G^l. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Jubb Fowler Messenger to the Govt.
& Council thirty one pounds five shillings on Account of his Salary. -
