That the said Treasurer pay to John Johnson five pounds twelve shillings and six pence due him for acct. passed by the Depty Aud. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Ballard one hundred and eighty pounds in lieu of sixty Pounds specie for a Horse sold Col: Lee's Capt by John Smith as Certificate of A. C. M. Lane of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Febry 1701 to be ch. to Cont. —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Christ<sup>n</sup> Reynes formerly a Soldier in the 4<sup>th</sup> Maryland Regiment transferred on account of his wound to the Corps of Invalids one Shirt one pair of Bonnets & one pair of Shoes. —

That the Collector of the Tag for Baltimore County pay to Col: Sam<sup>l</sup> Smith one hundred and ninety seven pounds eighteen shillings and six pence the Principal and Interest of a Certificate of A. C. M. Lane of the 20<sup>th</sup> January 1701 for a Horse purchased by him for Col: Lee's Legion to be charged to the Continent. —

James Macculbin Lingan appointed Captain, Philip Hill Lieut Horatio Erasmus Gantt Cornet of a Company of Cavalry directed to be raised by the Act for the Defense of the Bay. —

John Bussen appointed to purchase the Dragoon Horses for the above Company. —

Theodore Middleton appointed Capt Lieut<sup>t</sup> of a Company of Foot to serve in this State for one year.

George P. Keports appointed Captain and John M. Faden Capt Lieut<sup>t</sup> of the Fort to be erected on Drum point in Calvert County agreeable to the directions of the above mentioned Act. —
