

Ordered that Captain Taylor deliver to Thomas Conley and William O'Brien or their order Thirty Barrels of Flour from the cargo of the Schooner *Antelope* Commissioner issued to Jacob Brown appointed Second Lieut of Capt Bruffingham Dickinson Company in the Baltimore Town Battalion of Militia in Baltimore County. —

Warrants issued to the Lieutenant of Artillery and Calvet Guards directing them to arrest and bring Joshua Dowsay before the Governor and Council forthwith that he may be dealt with according to Law.

Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> April 1781

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt Jonathan Morris of the 7<sup>th</sup> Regt Fifty pounds agreeable to a Resolution of the General Assembly passed last session in favor of the Officers who had been in Captivity —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Hyde two hundred and fifty pounds on account of his Salary. —

That the said Treasurer pay to James Brooks Twenty two pounds ten Shillings for a Blank Book for the use of the Compt. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Adam Robb Five pounds twelve shillings and six pence due him on account paid by the Depy Aud. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Johnson Two pounds twelve shillings and six pence due him on acct. paid by the Depy Aud. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Ballard one hundred and eighty pounds in lieu of sixty Pounds Specie for advances made Col. Lee's Regt by John Smith as certificate of Dr. H Lane of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Feby 1781 to be ch'd to Compt.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to First Reynow formerly a Soldier in the 4<sup>th</sup> Maryland Regt transferred on account of his wounds to the Corps of Invalids one Third one pair of Bonnets & one pair of Shoes. —

That the Collector of the Tax for Baltimore County pay to Col. Sam'l Smith one hundred and ninety seven pounds eighteen shillings and six pence the Principal and Interest of a Certificate of Dr. H Lane of the 20<sup>th</sup> January 1781 for a Horse purchased by him for Col. Lee's Legion to be charged to the Compt. —

James MacCubbin Virgin appointed Captain Philip Hill Lieut Horatio Grasius Grant cornet of a Company of Cavalry directed to be raised by the Act for the Defence of the Bay. —

John Buffen appointed to purchase the Dragoon horses for the above Company. —

Theodore Middleton appointed Capt Lieut<sup>t</sup> of a Company of Foot to serve in this State for one year.

George Steeples appointed Captain and John McFadon Capt Lieutenant of the 1<sup>st</sup> to be created on Drum point in Calvert County agreeable to the direction of the above mentioned Act. —

Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> April 1781

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay Captain Francis Shepard and Lieut Charles Maguder of the Extra Regiment, each, Fifty pounds in lieu of Twenty pounds Specie in part of their Accounts paid by the Aud<sup>r</sup> General. —
