

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt Nathaniel Remond one hundred and twenty five pounds, fourteen shillings and three pence due him for Account paid by the Auditor General. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Redman one pound seventeen shillings and six pence due him per Account paid by the Deyy Aud. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Martin Storie twenty pounds, eight shillings and nine pence due him per Account paid by the Aud. Genl. —

Capt. Hyde Goodwin is appointed Surgeon to the Troop of light Horse raised in Baltimore Town and commanded by Col. Charles Prayton Moore. —

Capt. John Deaver was tried by a Court Martial held in Baltimore the 24<sup>th</sup> April 1781. whereof Col. Samuel Smith was President and sentenced to be cashiered, which sentence is confirmed by the Board and Commission given to James Pool appointed Captain in his room, Samuel Sader first Lieut and also to George Lucy first Lieut of Capt. Frederick Deans Company in the Baltimore Town Battalion of Militia in Baltimore County. —

Warrant issued Directed to Capt Gilbert Middleton to improve his Bonds for the purpose of Manning the State Boat Plate as aforesd.

Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> April 1781.
