

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Col. Nathaniel Hamdy one hundred and twenty five pounds, fourteen shillings and three pence due him per Account papered by the Aud<sup>r</sup> General. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Redman one pound fourteen shillings and six pence due him per Account papered by the Dep<sup>y</sup> Aud<sup>r</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Martin Morris twenty pounds, eight shillings and nine pence due him per Account papered by the Aud<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Linthicum fourteen pounds, three shillings and five pence due him per Account papered by the D. Aud<sup>r</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Campbelle a Lance Soldier of the 3<sup>d</sup> Regiment twenty pounds on Account. —

That the Armorer deliver to Col. Tootell twenty stand of Arms complete with Accoutrements and ten rounds of Cartridges for the use of a Guard of Militia ordered with the Prisoners of War in this City to Frederick Town to be by him accounted for. —

That the Assisting Commissary deliver to William Sanders Quarter Master for the West River Battalion of Militia, one Bushel of Salt for the use of the said Militia. —

Mr. Lyde Goodwin is appointed Surgeon to the Troop of light Horse raised in Baltimore Town and commanded by Nicholas Ruxton Moore. —

Capt John Deaver was tried by a Court Martial held in Baltimore the 24<sup>th</sup> April 1781. whereof Col. Samuel Smith was President and sentenced to be cashiered, which sentence is confirmed by this Board and Commission issued to James Pool appointed Captain in his room, Samuel Sadler first Lieut and also to George Lutz first Lieut of Capt Frederick Deavers Company in the Baltimore Town Battalion of Militia in Baltimore County. —

Warrant issued Directed to Capt Gilbert Middleton to impress six hands for the purpose of manning the State Boat Plater on a look out. —  
Friday 27<sup>th</sup> April 1781.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Abraham Lemaster eight hundred and thirty five pounds, two shillings and six pence for the use of himself and his Company of Militia on Account. —

That the said Treasurer pay to His Excellency Governor Lee one thousand five hundred Dollars for the use of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Daniel Lanoll Esq. on Acc<sup>t</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Hyde twelve pounds for the use of Doct<sup>r</sup> Michael Wallace due him per Account papered by the Dep<sup>y</sup> Aud<sup>r</sup>.

Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> April 1781.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Daniel of Saint Thomas Lenifer Esq. one thousand five hundred Dollars on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker five pounds, fourteen shillings and six pence due him per Account papered by the Dep<sup>y</sup> Aud<sup>r</sup>. —
