That the Newing Commissary deliver to Lieut William Amcock twenty three and a half Gallons of Rum and eighty pounds of Sugar and also to Lieutenant Thomas Rouse eight Gallons of Rum and thirty two pounds of Sugar due them to the 1st Instant -
