That the said Treasurer pay to Hannah May five Dollars per Account passed by the Adm. Genl. —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Sydebotham Seventy pounds fourteen shillings and six pence due him per Account passed by the Adm. Genl. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Elizabeth Isabell Seven pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence and also two pounds twelve shillings and six pence due her per Account passed by the Adm. Genl. —
