Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Ensign James Arthur of the 5<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> twenty one pounds and nine pence due him for Stores per account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to Brigadier General Gist one hundred pounds to enable him to proceed to the State of Delaware and Philadelphia on Business of Importance for the Southern States for which he is to be accountable to Major General Greene and that the said money be charged to the U States -

That the said Treasurer pay to Rachel Washington thirty one pounds five Shillings and six pence due him per acct<sup>ts</sup> passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to George Crookston seven hundred and twenty seven pounds two Shillings and three pence due him per acct<sup>ts</sup> passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> -

That the Flying Commissary deliver to Ensign James Arthur Twenty one Gallons of Rum and eighty pounds of Sugar due him to the 1<sup>st</sup> Instant -

Thomas Graffon is appointed Captain of the Barge Experiment agreeably to a Recommendation of the Special Council of the 3<sup>rd</sup> May 1781. -

A Negro Slave the property of John Eden of a<sup>th</sup> Kings County captured in the Sack of the Lantern by Capt Folger in the Antelope and now confined in the Goal of this City is delivered to said John Eden upon his agreeing to restore him on the Order of the Governor and Council or to pay the customary Charges whenever called on by the Governor and Council. -

Ordered that the Flying Commissary deliver to Capt Harrison three Days Provisions for two Men. -

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Lane Burk eighteen pounds due him per account passed by the Depty Aud<sup>g</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker six pounds eleven Shillings and three pence due him per account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> -

Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May 1781.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Gustavus Horner Surgeon of the General Hospital forty six pounds six Shillings due him for Stores per account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Edward Spurrion of the 5<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> eleven pounds eleven Shillings and six pence due him for Stores per account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to Jacob Trust fifty one pounds fourteen Shillings due him per account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Rulland one hundred and eighty four pounds and also the further Sum of eighty four pounds on account -
