Ordered that the Eastern Shores treasurer pay to Capt. Peter Adams Two hundred and fifty three pounds five shillings inclin of fifty five pounds, six shillings and three pence a' piece Principal and interest of a cert. of a M<sup>t</sup> Law and John Bullen dated 1<sup>st</sup> of March 1781 for an able boated house purchased by them for Lieut Col<sup>o</sup> Lee Legion. —

That the western shores treasurer pay to Dominica Selby eleven pounds two shillings and six pence due her per Account passed by the Adm<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>d</sup>. —

Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> May 1781.

Ordered that the western shores treasurer pay to John Akers one hundred and fifty eight pounds to be delivered over to Thomas Russell to pay for a fable purchased of Joseph Williams for the sloop a Mataponi her due passed by the Adm<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>d</sup>. But the said Treasurer pay to John Bullen three hundred pounds on Account. —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Spurrier Bowie five thousand and twenty five pounds of tobacco including sum present for Cark, for paper &c<sup>d</sup> purchased of him for the use of the Comit. —

That the said Treasurer pay to William a twin nine pounds, ten shillings and four pence per Account passed by the Adm<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>d</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Simon Sticholls Two hundred and forty six pounds inclin of fifty nine pounds, ten shillings Specie the Principal and Interest of a certificate of a M<sup>t</sup> Law and John Bullen dated 25 Decemb<sup>r</sup> 1780 for an able boated house purchased by them of Richard Ponsonby for Col<sup>o</sup> Lee Legt. —

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Simon Sticholls ninety eight pounds four shillings due him per Act. passed by the Adm<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>d</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty one hundred and ninety five pounds for the use of Samuel Boone per Account passed by the Adm<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>d</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Williams twenty six pounds six shillings and four pence due him per Account passed by the Adm<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>d</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Philip Shepherd thirteen pounds two shillings and six pence due him per Act. passed by the Adm<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>d</sup>. —
