That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Bagley one hundred and fifty pounds of the new Emission in lieu of thirty seven pounds ten shillings specie due him per account passed by the Aud^g Gen^l -

Richard Deale a Draught from the Militia of Ann Arundel County, having been refused by Col^o Adams Commandant in the City of Annapolis and having appeared before this Board on Examination is found to be unfit for the Service and is therefore Discharged. -

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Ralph Forster forty pounds on account of House Rent -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Martin Ridgeway five hundred and sixty one pounds, three shillings and four pence in lieu of one hundred and forty pounds, six shillings and ten pence specie for the use of his Company of Militia on account. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Col^o Samuel Smith two thousand six hundred and nineteen pounds, twelve shillings and six pence for the use of his Battalion of Militia on account. -
