Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Ralph Foster thirty pounds on account of House Renting

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Martin Ridderick two hundred and fifty one pounds, three shillings and four pence in lieu of one hundred and forty pounds, two shillings and ten pence Greek for the use of his Company of Militia on account. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Samuel Smith two thousand six hundred and nineteen pounds, twelve shillings and six pence for the use of his Battalion of Militia on account. —
