That the said Treasurer pay to Benjamin Eagle Esq forty one pounds paid passed by the Aud. G^l

That the said Treasurer pay to John Ballan Esq seven hundred eighty five pounds fifteen shillings & eight pence on acc^t

Permission given to Messrs Ridley and Pringle Merchants of Baltimore Town to transport to the City of Philadelphia for the use of the French Marine fifteen hundred barrels of Biscuit to be delivered to the Honble W. Holker Agent for the said Marine the barrels to be branded and the brands mentioned in the permits to be given by the Caval or other Officers.

David Lee and John Bond of Harford County severally recognized in the sum of one thousand pounds yete and silver for David Lee's good behaviour at all times and for his personal appearance before the Governor and Council of this State whenever he shall be thereunto required.

Whereas this Board have good reason to believe that William Bikey of Baltimore Town is a disaffected and dangerous person, whose going at large may be detrimental to the State. Capt Samuel Howard is therefore ordered to arrest the said William Bikey without delay and have him before the Board forthwith that he may be dealt with according to Law
