That the Lieutenant of Prince Georges County immediately arm equip
and march two Hundred Militia of his County under proper Officers to George
Town there to remain as aforesaid

That the Troops of Horse in Baltimore County the Troop in Kent
and the Troop in Frederick County immediately repair to George Town there to remain
subject to the further Order of this Board.

Commissions issued to Thomas Frampton Lieut and Benoni
Swearingan Ensign of Capt Joseph Chaplins Company of Select Militia
in Washington County - and also to Benjamin Nicholson appointed Captain
Charles Larnan Lieut and Thomas Cromwell Cornet of a Troop of Horse
raised in Baltimore County in virtue of the "Act to encourage the raising of
Volunteer Troop of Light Horse &c."

Twenty five pair of Shoes for the Recruits raised in Washington County

That the western Store Treasurer deliver to Philip Key Esq.
Two Hundred and thirty three Hides of Tobacco on Chaplins, Lewellins and
Leonard Town Warehouses in St. Marys County to be by him transported to
Philadelphia and to be accounted for. -

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Brigadier General
Gist twenty four Shirts of Lin to be by him paid for and also Capt Edward
Hall of Spencers Regiment Cloth and Trimmings for one Suit of Cloaths and
Linen for six Shirts in part of the Articles for the Years 1700 & 1701. -

That the Young Commissary deliver to Capt Edward Hall
Thirty four Gallons of Rum and one hundred and thirty six pounds of Sugar
due him to the first Instant. -
