Corps Cloth and Trimmings for a shirt of Cloths and Linen for four shirts - Capt  
Pegruine Fitzhugh of the same Corps Cloth and trimmings for a shirt of Cloths and  
Linen for two Shirts and also to Captain William Reily of the 4<sup>th</sup> Regiment Linen  
for two Shirts and Hems for the year 1781 -

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt Joseph Chapline Three  
hundred pounds for the use of himself and his Company of Select Militia and  
also two hundred and eighty pounds to be delivered over to Capt Adam BH for  
the use of himself and Company of Select Militia under marching Orders for  
George Town on Potowmack agreeable to a Resolution of the General Assembly  
of this Day to be by them accounted for -

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> June 1781

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut James John  
Kinner facings for a coat he having received an order for them some time past which  
was not complied with -
