Ordered that the Young Commissary deliver to Major John Eccleston Ten Gallons of Rum and forty pounds of Sugar and Linn to the 1st Instant. -

That Richard Daltam Esq^r deliver to Col^o Samuel Smith one hundred and fifty Bunches of public Flour in his hands

On the Resignation of the Honble General Smallwood Lieut Col^o Peter Adams, Lieut Col^o James Tostell, Major John Eccleston and John Davidson and Captains Jonathan Sellman, John Courts Jones, Edward Prall, John Mitchell and Nicholas Maucubbin Jun^r are appointed a Court of Judicature for the Trial of Thomas Doyle suspected and apprehended as a Spy or Emisary from the Enemy.

Wednesday 20th June 1781.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut Jacob Gromith of the German Regiment Cloth and Trimmings for a suit of Cloaths and linen for four shirts and Linn for the year 1780 and also to Commodore Thomas Grafer some shirts of Linn for the use of the Barges belong to the State

That the Armourer deliver to the said Commodore Grafer five Jewel Guns, three Formers, twelve Puckers, twenty four Tompions, six touch hole bits and what Jewel Ball he may want for the above ment^d Barges. -

That the Young Commissary deliver to the said Commodore Grafer five Days Provisions for himself and Crew of the Barge Revenge. -
