That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Dyer Bolton fourteen pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him per Account passed by the said Aud. Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Nathaniel Crooks two pounds fourteen shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him per Account passed by the Aud. Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Munro two pounds eight shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid per Account passed by the Depy Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Daniel Bryan twenty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Defence of the State to be by him expended in repairing the State Boat Plates and accounted for. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson Junior twenty two pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid on Account.

That the Commissary of stores deliver to Philip Bailey a Soldier of the 4th Regiment one Coat, one Jacket, one pair Breeches, two shirts and hat, one pair shoes and one knapsack - Thomas Grafer seven shirts and seven pair Breeches for the use of the hands of the Barge Terrible belonging to the State. - Ensign Henry Baker two and a quarter yards of rusia Duck on Account, and also to Lieut Sigual Hilleary of the 3^d Regiment two and a quarter yards rusia Duck on Account.

That the Shipping Commissary deliver to Capt John McGowan three Days rations for three hands of the Sloop Junco impressed in the public service by D. Poe. -

Commissions issued to Raigh Hilleary appointed Capt. Joseph Chadding Lieut. and Thomas Hilleary Ensign of a company of Select Militia raised in Frederick County.

Commissions issued to Daniel Shuler appointed Captain in the room of John Carmack, George Brown 1st Lieut, John Shoemaker 2^d Lieut, Christopher Need Ensign and also to Jacob Collins appointed Captain in the room of William Carmack - Solomon Bentley 1st Lieut. Christian Smith 2^d Lieut and John Wood Ensign, belonging to the Colonel's Battalion of Militia in Frederick County. -
