Joseph Mark 2nd Lieut, Luomish Loomis Ensign in the upper Battalion of Militia in Dorchester County and also to John Budd 1st Lieut, John & Aaron Ensigns of Joseph Robinson's Company. John Kane Captain in the room of Benjamin Kane Richard Tushman 1st Lieut, John Griffith 2nd Lieut, Benjamin Kane Ensign, belong to the Lower Battalion of Militia in the County & forward. —

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Christopher Graft Twelve Pounds eighteen Shillings and nine pence of the Bills of Credit emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding 200,000 £d^{rs} of the money appropriated for the present Campaign due him per Account passed. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Philip Hill two Pounds seventeen Shillings and three pence of the same Emission, of the money appropriated as aforesaid for Clothing on Account. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Hutton Three pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him per Ac^t. passed by the Ac^t.

That the said Treasurer pay to Stephen West Esquire two hundred and pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid to be by him expended in purchasing mounting, and repairing one hundred and fifties belonging to the public on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Stephen West one hundred pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid for three hundred and forty Socks which he has engaged to deliver the State not less than twenty five p^{er} Week to be accounted for. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Mark & M^{rs} Pherson Twenty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid to be delivered over to Francis Ware jun^r and Edward Hamilton, each, Ten pounds on Account, they being appointed Ensigns in the Maryland Line. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Reginald Hillary of the 3rd Regiment Three pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid for Stores on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Captain Robert Denny Two pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid to be delivered over to Stephen Preston a Soldier of the Maryland Line returned from Captivity in South Carolina in a distressed situation on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Carroll jun^r. ninety eight pounds, nine shillings and four pence half penny of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Defense of this State to be delivered over to Dan^l Carroll Esq. on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joshua Trazier Three hundred and seventy six pounds, five shillings and six pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State due him for Cert^s settled by the Aud^g Gen^l 21st Inst.

That the said Treasurer pay to Nathan Hammond two hundred pounds, eighteen shillings and six pence specie agreeable to the Act above mentioned due him on Certificates settled by the Aud^g Gen^l. —
