

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker two pounds, eight shillings of the Bills emitted under the act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding 200,000 £ of the money appropriated for the present Campaign per Account passed by the Deputy Auditor.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Smith six pounds, six shillings and eight pence of the same Emission of the money aforesaid per Act passed by the Deputy Auditor -

That the said Treasurer pay to James Tootell, fifteen pounds twelve shillings of the same Emission, of the money aforesaid due him as Auctioneer for selling 12 Lots British property in Annapolis Plat passed by D. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Henry Gasaway Ten pounds, ten shillings - Capt Alexander Trueman fifteen shillings and to Capt Robert Churchly four pounds, ten shillings of the same Emission, of the money aforesaid for Stores on Account -

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Brewer six thousand, seven hundred and fifty pounds of the same Emission, of the money aforesaid to be delivered over as follows, one thousand, seven hundred pounds to the Commissary of Somerset County one thousand, seven hundred pounds to Peter Charles Esq.
