

Edward Johnson, Walter Smith & James Hughs Judges of the Orphans Court of Cabot County

Thursday 20th September 1701.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Doct Henry Schnobely sixty nine pounds, nine shillings and three pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debt due from this State per Account passed by the Asst. Genl. the 19th Instant -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Christopher Grandorff fifteen pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c of the money appropriated for the present Campaign for Stores on Account -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Richard Anderson of the 4th Regiment nine pounds, nineteen shillings and six pence of the same Emission of the money aforesaid for Stores on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to John D. Farney and Thomas Beatty Junr. appointed Ensigns in the Maryland Line each ten pounds of the same Emission of the money aforesaid on Account -

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct. Henry Schnobely thirty eight pounds, two shillings and seven pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Defense of the State to be delivered over to Henry Gost per Account passed by the Asst. Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt John Reed three hundred and seventy five pounds of the same Emission of the money as on Act.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Christ: Grandorff six Gallons of Rum and twenty four pounds of sugar and also to Capt Richard Anderson thirty five and an half gallons of Rum and ninety three pounds of sugar to the 1st Instant on Account.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to John D. Farney and Thomas Beatty Junr. each a Suit of Cloaths & Linen for two Shirts on Act.

Friday 21. September 1701.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Lt. Col. Nath: Forrest sixty five pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c of the money appropriated for the Defense of the State in part of his Salary as Commissioner on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Shanks Twenty one pounds, one shilling and nine pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debt due from this State per Account passed by the Asst. Genl. 17th Inst.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Regm Davis thirty pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c of the money appropriated for the present Campaign on Account.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to the said Capt Regm Davis a Suit of Cloaths and Linen for two Shirts on Account -
