Ordered that the ^{Young} Commissary deliver to Col^o Thomas Woolford twenty four gallons of Rum and ninety six pounds of Sugar to the 1st Instant and also to Elizabeth Murphy a soldiers wife of the 2^d Maryland Regiment one ration per Day until further order -

Thursday 27 September 1701

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Bullen seventy pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit ~~and~~ of the money appropriated for the present Campaign on Account and also to Captain James Buchanan four pounds, ten shillings of the same Emission of the money aforesaid his expenses in carrying Dispatches from his Excellency Gen^l Washington to the French fleet.

That the said Treasurer pay to Col^o Thomas Woolford twenty five pounds of the same Emission of the money aforesaid on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Zedekiah Walley one hundred pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Defence of the State to be delivered over to the E shore Treasurer.

That the Young Commissary deliver to Lieut Isaac Fenton one Band of Tom for the use of the select Militia of Somerset County who brought up the State Barge from Salisbury -

Friday 20th September 1701.

John Mills a Draught from St Marys County, having made it appear to this Board by his Oath and Certificates from several Militia Officers in St Marys County that he was enrolled in the select Militia of said County before the Draught for raising two Battalions took place in the said County. He is hereby Discharged as not being liable to be Draughted -

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Sergeant Easter of the Maryland Artillery one Coat, two shirts, one pair woollen overalls, one pair shoes, one pair stockings, one Stock & one Blanket for the year.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Captain William Bruce of the 5th Regim^t eighteen pounds, three shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit ~~and~~ of the money appropriated for the present Campaign for provisions for Account passed by the Aud. Gen^l & to be charged to the Continent -

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Dawson, seventeen pounds, fourteen shillings of the same Emission of the money aforesaid for clothing purchased of Dawson and Bowman per Ac^t passed by the Aud. Gen^l -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Horatio Blagett, sixteen pounds, fifteen shillings of the same Emission of the money aforesaid for retained rations per Ac^t passed by the Aud. Gen^l & to be charged to the Continent.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Wolfe two hundred and fifty pounds of the same Emission of the money aforesaid to be delivered over to Pat^r Jm^s Smith Com^r of Calvert County on Account and also to the said Wolfe fifteen pounds of the same Em^o of the money appropriated for the payment of Expenses per per Account passed by the Aud. Gen^l -
