

Ordered that the Army Commissary deliver to William Banick some Days rations to enable him to return to Frederick with two men -

Saturday 29th September 1781.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Frederick Green some pounds ten Shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c. of the money appropriated for the present Campaign and him for Postage of Letters to the 5th July last -

That the said Treasurer pay to William Biggs one hundred and forty six pounds sixteen Shillings and eight pence farthing of the same Emission, of the money aforesaid for the use of Clark and Biggs due them per Account passed by the Aud. Genl -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut William Adams of the 2^d Regiment one pound ten Shillings of the same Emission of the money aforesaid for Store on Account -

That the Army Commissary deliver to Adam Bayor all the raw Hides belonging to the public agreeable to the Agreement entered into by Philip Thomas Esq. in behalf of the State. Thomas Rogers provisions for four men 3 Days in Wagoning Store to George Town - Lieut William Adams some gallons of Rum and fifteen pounds of sugar to the 1st of Oct.^r and also to Maria Senese wife of Lewis Senese of Genl Rochambeau's Army two Days rations -

That the Quarter Master deliver to Thomas Rogers three Days Storage for fifteen Horses to George Town. -

Daniel Brown a Substitute from Capt Gentry appearing to be an indentured Servant to Thomas J. Burling of Baltimore County from an Indenture produced to the Board dated 29th April 1779 by which for a valuable Consideration the said Daniel Brown engages to the said T. J. Burling for the term of three years, is therefore discharged and ordered to return into the Service of the said Burling. -

Permission is hereby given to Miss Mary V. Courtlandt to accompany Mrs Hughes, who obtained a conditional permission from this Board, to go into the City of New York and to return. -

Monday 1st October 1781.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Boyle and Hackburn thirty pounds eleven Shillings and three pence of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c. of the money appropriated for the present Campaign, due them per Account passed by the Aud. Genl. -

Tuesday 2^d October 1781.

Ordered that Mr Shaw deliver to Capt Stevens the entrenching Tools lately received of Doct. E Howard taking Capt Stevens rec^d therefor -

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to George Adams one thousand two hundred pounds of the Bills of Credit emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c. of the money approp^d for the present Campaign to be delivered over to the Special Council on Account -
