Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Stone Eight hundred and thirty eight pounds ten Shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emprison of Bills of Credit &c of the money appropriated for the present Campaign to be delivered over to Thomas E. Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Mary Ghise - four hundred and eighteen pounds eight Shillings and five pence - William Lyles one hundred and twenty nine pounds ten Shillings & to Benjamin Rumsey three hundred and twenty two pounds eight Shillings and six pence Specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Accounts & Vouchers passed by the A. G.

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct. James Murray fifty pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emprison of Bills of Credit &c of the money appropriated for the present Campaign to be expended in purchasing Wine & other Necessaries for the use of the Hospital on Account

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to John Bullen Esq. sixteen Blankets and Linen for 14 Beds for the use of the sick soldiers in the Hospital. -

Saturday 6th October 1701.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Joshua Bowen thirty pounds fifteen Shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emprison of Bills of Credit &c of the money appropriated for the present Campaign - nine pounds part thereof to be by him retained and the balance to be delivered over as follows six pounds fifteen Shillings to Sgt Darby Lieut. six pounds to James Goran - three pounds to Solomon Bowen three pounds to Jacob Young and three pounds to John Riely due them per Accounts passed by the Aud.
