

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to William Giddings Ten Pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit on Bounty allowed for manufacturing Salt per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Maddox Ten Pounds ten Shillings of the said Emission due him per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to George Mann Six Pounds Three Shillings and three Pence of the same Emission to be delivered over to Captain Abraham Gorman in lieu of an Order on the Western shore Treasurer of the 13th March 1701 adjusted and passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Richard Potts Esquire twenty six Pounds nine Shillings and eight Pence of the same Emission for the use of William Magruder in lieu of an Order of the 30th March 1701 adjusted and passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to William Gutchall nineteen Pounds, eighteen Shillings and nine Pence of the same Emission due on a Certificate issued agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State
Friday 21st June 1702

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Nicholas Thomas Esq^r sixty Pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit on account of his Salary on Account. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Green Two Hundred Pounds of the same Emission on Account of Printing. -

By the House of Delegates June 15. 1702

Resolved that it is the opinion of this General Assembly, that this State ought to credit the United States by W. Conrad Theodore Wedenstrandt for the sum of five thousand one hundred and eighty two Pounds and nine pence specie for seven thousand nine hundred and ninety six and three quarters Bushels of Wheat purchased by him for the use of the Fortmunk, and seized by Officers of this State and that the Governor and Council be requested to give W. Wedenstrandt a Certificate of said Credit having been duly entered in favor of the United States.

Annapolis In Council 21 June 1702

In consequence of the above Resolution of the General Assembly, and in Pursuance of their directions, it is hereby certified that the United States are Credited by Conrad Theodore Wedenstrandt on the Books of this State for five thousand one hundred and eighty two Pounds and nine Pence specie. -

Saturday 22nd June 1702

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Donwick, one Pound thirteen Shillings and four pence & Sarah Blake one Pound, thirteen Shillings and six Pence of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit due them per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut John Chew Ten pounds five Shillings for Store to 1st July on Account of seven Pounds two Shillings of the same Em^{ission} issued passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John H Stone Esq^r one hundred and twenty two Pounds of the same Emission for a Quarter Salary in July last on Account
