navigated by twenty five men, mounting eight Sailing Guns and eight
Swivels, belonging to Messrs. Remy, Demare, Martin De Perrenon and
Dewalt Subjects of his most Christian Majesty -

Commission of Letters of Marque and Repulse issued to Lewis
Lucas Commander of the Brigantine *Stee* seventy Tons burthen navigated by
fifteen men, mounting eight Sailing Guns, belonging to John Ouel de
Bleger of York Town State of Virginia. -

Whereas it appears to this Board by the Representation and
Recommendation of Thomas Johnson Esq. that General Harrington of the
State of North Carolina hath removed into this State for the preservation of
his Property and is entitled to the Indulgence granted to Persons under such
Circumstances in the Act to raise the Supplies for the Year fourteen hundred
and eighty two; the said General Harrington has the Approbation of this
Board to settle in this State. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Hanson
Esq. fifty Pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills
of Credit due the Interest and part of the Principal of a Certificate issued agreeable
to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State for which a Receipt is to
be given on the back of the Certificate. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Hamilton eleven Pounds
thirteen shillings and four pence - Robert Dennis twelve Pounds, and John Dicks
thirteen Pounds, one shilling and eight Pence of the same Emission per Act passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Clement Skerrett twenty
three Pounds, thirteen shillings for Allowance to the 1st July; and also thirty Pounds
of the same Emission value of a suit of Cloaths & four Shirts for the
present year on Account. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Robert Denny thirteen
Pounds ten shillings Specie to be delivered over to Lieut Clement Skerrett
part of the thirty Pounds allotted to be advanced by the Act relating to Public
Creditors and to be accounted for. -

Tuesday 25th June 1702

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Roger McAllister
thirteen Pounds six shillings and six Pence of the Bills emitted under the Act
for the Emission of Bills of Credit due on two Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Morgan one hundred and six
Pounds, nine shillings and four Pence Specie agreeable to the Act to adjust
the Debts due from this State per Certificate adjusted and Passed. -
