

Ordered that the western shro pay to Christiana Emery the
wife of John Emery a soldier with the 2^d Regiment who was wounded
& taken at the Battle of Landen as appears by a Letter from General Small-
wood to the Orphans Court of Anne Arundel County seven Pounds ten shillings
of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit due
as Subsidance, there being no application made to the Orphans Court
of St. Marys County at present to which County the Husband belonged and
to be deducted out of the Allowance hereafter to be made by the Court

Tuesday 2^d July 1702

fifteen shillings to Lieut William Adams due them in lieu of Orders on the
Spring Commissary for Store on Account & which were not furnished. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Morgan eleven Pounds
nine shillings and four pence of the same Emission due him for a quit rent

That the said Treasurer pay to Lewis Nath nineteen Pounds, ten
shillings of the same Emission in part of his Salary on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Digges just eighty eight
Pounds and eight Pence and John Crisall twenty five Pounds, nine shillings
and two Pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this
State in Certificates adjusted and Passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Crisall fourteen Pounds
one shilling and three pence specie due him for Money lent the State June
1700 per Certificate passed. -

Wednesday 3^d July 1702

Ordered that the western shro Treasurer pay to John Crisall four
hundred and ninety Pounds, fourteen shillings and eight pence of the Bills em-
-itted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit due Balance of Account passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Japho Hebb eighty three Pounds
ten shillings of the same Emission to be delivered over as follows, ten Pounds
to George Guy - twelve Pounds, eight shillings to Richard all Kay - four Pounds
ten shillings to John Maltand - five Pounds four shillings to Joshua Redman
five Pounds to Thomas Hebb. - fifteen Pounds to Japho Hebb, twenty four
Pounds, eight shillings to Thomas Waughop & seven Pounds to George Cole, the
Bounty allowed for manufacturing Salt in Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Ashmead thirty one Pounds
nine shillings & two Pence of the same Emission due on Account passed.
