Ordered that the western Show Treasurer pay to John Connolly fourteen Pounds fifteen shillings - John Loring eleven Pounds, eighteen shillings and four Pence and Elizabeth Spabell four Pounds, five shillings of the Bills emitted under the act for the Emission of Bills of Credit due them per Accounts passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Benjamin Starwood forty nine Pounds, one shilling and eight Pence of the same Emission due him for a Specie Certificate.

That the said Treasurer pay to Christian Grendoff thirty Pounds agreeable to a Resolution of this Board of the 22^d July 1701 - Sixty Pounds value of two Suits of Cloaths and eight Shirts for the last and present years and twenty five Pounds, fourteen shillings of the same Emission for Stores to the first instant on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Thompson sixteen Pounds five shillings & two pence of the same Emission due on a Certificate issued agreeable to the act to adjust the Debts due from this State.

Permission granted to Peter Ulric of Frederick County to solicit leave from His Excellency General Washington or the Commanding Officer at the Out Posts of the American Army for License to go into the City of New York for the Purpose of obtaining a Passage from thence to Germany to settle among his Friends.

Friday 12th July 1702

Ordered that the western Show Treasurer pay to Capt Daniel Bruen forty Pounds of the Bills emitted under the act for the Emission of Bills of Credit due on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Rawlings forty one Pounds, thirteen shillings - Hezekiah Wood, ten Pounds, ten shillings - John Deane twelve Pounds, five shillings & John Green one Pound ten shillings of the same Emission due them per Accounts passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Dove, Twenty Pounds of the same Emission for the use of John McDaniel & James McDaniel per Accounts passed.
