

A Letter of the 22nd Instant from Lt. Thomas Price Commissary of
Tudor County this day received, mentioning that he had delivered to Colo
Moses Rawlings agreeable to the Order of this Board, nine hundred and fifty
Barrels containing 5705 and 2 Quarters long hundred which is equal to one
hundred and ninety nine thousand, nine hundred and seventy six & three Quar
ters short hundreds of Public Flour, and desiring to be informed what
is to be done with the poor Cattle which he had ventured among the
Farmers, was read and referred to the Intendant

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to William Watts five
teen Pounds, ten shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission
of Bills of Credit &c to be delivered over as follows, three Pounds ten
shillings to Moses Flower - five Pounds to John M Kay and seven
Pounds to William Barton Smoot due them per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to William Watts Surgeon eleven
in the Maryland Line five Pounds of the same Emission in lieu of two
Suits of Cloaths and eight Shirts for the last & present year on Account

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Sub Fowler one
Barrel of Flour on Account

The Order on the Commissary of Stores of the 15th August
1701 in favor of William Watts for a Suit of Cloaths & two Shirts, not
having been completed with is returned -

Friday 26th July 1702

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to William Bayly Esq.
four hundred and six Pounds, and eight pence of the Bills emitted under the
Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c due on four Certificates issued agreeable
to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State and also forty eight Pounds
and one Penny of the same Emission per Certificate of Robert Bowie passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robertson Stevens thirty eight
Pounds ten shillings - Hannah May, Alys Redmond & Mary Connolly, each
one Pound ten shillings - John Sumner five Pounds and Henry Say
thirteen Pounds, fifteen shillings of the same Emission due them per Ac^{ts} passed

That the said Treasurer pay to Robertson Stevens three Pounds
five shillings specie due him per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Lieut James M'Fadden
and Capt James Smith, each, five Pounds, fifteen shillings and nine
pence specie part of the money directed to be advanced by the "Act relating
to Public Creditors" on Account.

Saturday 27th July 1702

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to the Honble
Daniel Janoll Esq. one of the Delegates to Congress four hundred and ninety
seven Pounds, eighteen shillings and four pence specie on Account -
