Monday 29th July 1702.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to William Logan twelve Pounds, seven shillings and four Pence of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c for the use of Hillary Wilson due him for a State loan Office Certificate N^o 002 which was lost by Samuel Chew Esq. as appears by the Deposition of the said Chew

That the said Treasurer pay to James Robinson nine Pounds, fifteen shillings of the same Emission, two Pounds, fifteen shillings thereof to be delivered over to Joseph Hickland & seven Pounds to John Woodfield due them per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Barnes nine Pounds, fifteen shillings and eight pence - James Demison eleven Pounds, thirteen shillings and three Pence - James Hunter Ten pounds five shillings - & Francis Marbury twenty nine Pounds, fifteen shillings and nine Pence of the same Emission due them per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Joshua Burgess forty two Pounds, four shillings and three pence of the same Emission on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Robert Dabell forty two Pounds, fifteen shillings of the same Emission, twenty one Pounds thereof to be by him retained, fourteen Pounds to be delivered over to Lieut Oakly Maddaway & the residue seven pounds, fifteen shillings to Charles Camper due them per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut John Lavacher four Pounds six shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c for State on Account -

That the said Treasurer pay to Zephaniah Turner Esq. seventy eight Pounds, fourteen shillings & six Pence of the same Emission for the use of Richard Bond due him per Account passed. -
