

Thursday 1st August 1782.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt Lewis Spedden eighty Pounds, eighteen shillings and four pence of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &c twenty one Pounds to be by him retained fourteen Pounds to Capt Edward Spedden, fourteen Pounds to Litch Gaddock Bodfute and the residue thirty one Pounds, eighteen shillings and four pence to Summary Persons per Accounts passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Rippon Bozman one hundred and twenty five Pounds three shillings and ten pence of the same Emission seven Pounds, eight shillings and four pence to be by him retained and the residue to be delivered over as follows, eight Pounds eighteen shillings and four pence to Thomas Mure - fourteen Pounds to Thomas Dixon - seven Pounds, four shillings to Capt George Waters & his Guard, eighteen Pounds, one shilling and two pence to Capt John Jones and his Guard - thirty four Pounds, eighteen shillings and two pence to Enf. John Jones - fourteen Pounds, one shilling and eight pence to Enf. James Luster and twenty Pounds, four shillings to Henry Mure due them per Accounts passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas & Cannon nineteen Pounds ten shillings, and William Hutchings three Pounds, seventeen shillings and four pence of the same Emission due them per Accounts passed.

On the Application of Stephen Steward Certificate was given to Capt James Commander of the Brigantine Nesbitt, one hundred and twenty five men, navigating thirty five men, mounting twelve Carriage Guns - belonging to Stephen Steward & Son of Maryland and a John Mergwell Nesbitt of Philadelphia -

That the said Treasurer pay to James Atwood one hundred and four Pounds, eleven shillings and six pence of the same Emission, six Pounds, ten shillings thereof to be by him retained - & the residue to be delivered over as follows, six Pounds two shillings to George Deane - five Pounds, seventeen shillings & six pence to William Deane - one Pound twelve shillings to Austin Maffey - four Pounds, ten shillings to Thomas Clarke - ten Pounds three shillings to William Locker - eight Pounds, seven shillings & six pence to Messrs Davis, four Pounds, one shilling to Robert Deane - seven pounds, eight shillings & six pence to William Manner - six Pounds, seventeen shillings to Stephen Milburn - one Pound, fifteen shillings to Mr. Evans - four Pounds to John Deane junr. twelve shillings to John Dalton, five Pounds, ten shillings to Richard Milburn - four Pounds, ten shillings to Jonathan Thorp
