and Charles Turms, Gunner of the Barge Protector and Warrants issued. -

Commission issued to Lem Handy appointed Captain of Marines
onboard the Barge Protector. -

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to John Alexander
and George Baker each, ten Pounds, five shillings of the Bills emitted under
the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit due them per Accounts passed. -

Friday 9th August 1702

Ordered that the Eastern Shore Treasurer pay to Col. Richard
Dallam two hundred Pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission
of Bills of Credit due on Account. -

That the said Treasurer pay to James Harris fourteen Pounds
fifteen shillings of the same Emission due him per Account passed. -

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Col. Ulrich Trout
sixty Pounds specie, out of the money arising from the specie Tax due him on Certificates
