Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to James Gorman  
 sixteen Pounds - Valentine Dewitt, nine Pounds, thirteen shillings and  
 four Pence & Robert Bradley Tyler fifteen Pounds, one Shilling & eight  
 Pence Specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debt due from this State  
 per Account passed -

Commission of Letters of Marque & Reprisal issued to  
 Joseph Dorly Commander of the Ship Phoenix two hundred Tons burthen  
 navigated by thirty five men, mounting ten carriage Guns, belonging to  
 Isaac, Abraham & Andrew Kaubiber of Baltimore -

Sunday 26 August 1782

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Alice Redmond  
 Mary Connolly & Mary Norton, each one Pound, two shillings & six Pence  
 Specie due them per Account passed -

That the said Treasurer pay to Stewart & Maxwell nineteen  
 Pounds, one Shilling and six Pence Specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the  
 Debt due from this State per Account passed 11<sup>th</sup> June last

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Simon Wickes  
 four Pounds, five Shillings - Stephen Hodges seven Pounds, one  
 Shilling & three Pence & Hugh McLaughlin six Pounds, ten shillings  
 Specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debt due from this State per  
 Account and Certificate passed -

That the Eastern Shore Treasurer pay to James Hodges  
 seven Pounds, eight shillings and one Penny of the Bills emitted under  
 the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit ten two Pounds, sixteen  
 shillings & two pence thereof to be delivered over to Hannah Mites -  
 - all & the residue four Pounds, eight shillings & eleven Pence to John  
 Davis allowed them by the Orphans Court of Kent County per Order  
 adjusted and passed -

Furnished Major Davidson with a Keam of common writing  
 Paper for the use of the troops in this City -

Permission is hereby granted to the Schooner Trimmer  
 John Cog & Master, navigated by himself and Miles Union & John Scott  
 to proceed to Baltimore & Land the Household Furniture & Effects of  
 Mrs Chamis agreeable to an Inventory annexed -

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to William  
 Hanjan & W Pherson twelve hundred & thirty five Pounds of Tobacco for the  
 use of William W Pherson for the like Quantity lent the State in June 1780  
 per Certificate adjusted -

That the said Treasurer pay to Allen Luyam Esq  
 seventy nine Pounds, three shillings and nine Pence Specie due him per  
 Account passed -

That the Young Commissary deliver to John New  
 four Bunches Flour on Account
