

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Stephen Guffith five Pounds, ten shillings and eleven Pence, John Lagett three Pounds, ten shillings and seven Pence - John Willing ten shillings and eight Pence - Daniel Whelan one Pound eleven shillings and seven Pence - Lucy Orms three Pounds eight shillings and one Penny - Samuel Turner two Pounds one shilling and James Groome two Pounds specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Accounts passed -

Commission of Letters of Marque and Reprisal issued to George Duck Commander of the Brigantine Sea Bell one hundred and fifty tons burthen, navigated by twenty one men, mounting six Carriage Guns belonging to John Mc Lane and company of Baltimore - Roger Boyer Commander of the Brigantine Ranger one hundred and thirty tons burthen navigated by thirty men, mounting ten Carriage Guns, belonging to Daniel Dowley and others of Baltimore - and also to William Howard Commander of the Schooner Aquil one hundred and one tons burthen, navigated by twenty two men mounting four Carriage Guns belonging to Archibald Buchanan and others of Baltimore -

Permission given to Mary Laycock late the wife of a Private Soldier taken at the Reduction of York in Virginia who died in this City, to return to New York in the Shipper Captain Lee a Flag of Truce now lying in the Harbour -

Wednesday 28th August 1782

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Deale six Pounds - William Ford just two Pounds - and John Baltzer eight Pounds fifteen shillings and three pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Accounts passed -

That the said Treasurer pay to George Scott Esq^r twenty Pounds specie out of the money arising from the Specie Tax due on a Certificate given to William Magruder by Robert Bowie one of the Persons appointed in virtue of the Act to furnish the Southern Army with twenty Dragoon Horses -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Horatio Lagett for the use of Thomas Marshall forty Pounds, ten shillings and eight pence half penny specie to be paid out of the twenty thousand Pounds appropriated for the Payment of Creditors of a particular description due from the one half of a certificate (including Interest), issued agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State

Commission of Letters of Marque & Reprisal issued to Edward Peters Commander of the Schooner Return eighty four tons burthen navigated by seventeen men, mounting six Carriage Guns belonging to Thomas Johnson, David Reep & David Patterson of Maryland -

Thursday 29th August 1782

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Francis Kerkey for the use of Peter Humber eight Pounds, fifteen shillings specie paid into the Treasury by him for caution money as appears by a Warrant
