

Whereas *Thomas Lambert* one of the Officers of the Ship *Romulus* belonging to the King of France and now lying at the Port of Baltimore hath made Oath that he has good cause to suspect & doth suspect that several deserters from the said ship whose names are unknown to him but whose persons he is well acquainted with, are harboured on board the Ship *Matilda*, You are hereby required & authorized to enter into the said *Matilda* with the said *Thomas Lambert* & search for the said deserters and if they shall be found, to bring them before this board. Given in Council this 3^d Day of Sept. 1782. -

Wednesday 4th September 1782

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to *John Nicholls* eight Pounds, fifteen shillings - *Capt. Garah Harding*, thirty three Pounds six shillings & four Pence - *Capt. James Elliott* one hundred and fifty Pounds eight shillings & two Pence - *John Gump* seventeen shillings & three Pence - *Lawrence Bringle* and *Jacob Gember* twenty eight Pounds, seven shillings & six Pence - *John Grove* three Pounds, ten shillings and eleven Pence - *Jacob Hobb* twenty three Pounds, eighteen shillings and four Pence - *Jacob Holly* twenty five Pounds, five shillings & one Penny - *John Ramburgh* forty two Pounds, fourteen shillings and six Pence & fifty Pounds, nine shillings and ten Pence - *George Baker* seven Pounds - *John Semolly* ten Pounds - *Patrick Dolera* three Pounds, fifteen shillings - *Capt. Jacob Schley* twenty Pounds - *Basel Johnson* one Pound - and *Abraham Lemaster* seven Pounds and three Pence Given agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debt due from this State" per Accounts and Certificates passed. -

Thursday 5 September 1782

Permission is hereby given to *Capt. Frederick Baker* of this State to solicit His Excellency General Washington leave to go into the City of New York for the Purpose of applying for a Flag to bring from thence to Baltimore Town the household furniture of *Richard Lysen Esquire* Merchant in said Town. -

Friday 6 September 1782

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to *Capt. Perry Benson* forty one Pounds, sixteen shillings & four Pence - and *Richard Hutchings* fifty one Pounds, eight shillings and one Penny Given agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debt due from this State" per Act & Cert. passed. -
That the said Treasurer pay to *Hugh McBryde Esq.* fifteen shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit for the use of *William Douglass* per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to *Sub. Fowler* fifty two Pounds ten shillings - *Sec. Toroh Chas Esq.* eighty seven Pounds, ten shillings - *James Maule Esq.* thirty three Pounds, six shillings & eight Pence - *Benj. Stoddard Esq.* one hundred & seventy five Pounds - & *Joseph Duma* thirty seven Pounds, ten shillings of the same Emission in part of their Salaries on Account
