Ordered that the western Shew Treasurer pay to a Hordcai Jones and a May Jones nine Pounds, sixteen Shillings and six Pence of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit for premium for Manufacturing Salt per Account passed. -

Permission is hereby given to Anthony Addison of Prince Georges County to apply to his Excellency General Washington on the Officers commanding at the Out Posts of the American Army for Leave to have an interview on the Lines with the Rev. Mr. Henry Addison. -

The Intendant informs the Board, that he has found by experience that the Flour manufactured in the different Counties will generally over pay Inspection - that the transportation of Wheat to places of Market amounts to more than the difference of prices in the Counties and at the market places - Wherefore he proposes to sell the Wheat at the places where it is received and to stop the manufacturing of it into Flour, which was agreed to by the Board. -

Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September 1782

Ordered that the western Shew Treasurer pay to Elis. Dorsey forty seven Pounds, seventeen Shillings & nine pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State -

Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September 1782

Ordered that the western Shew Treasurer pay to Capt. Isaac Layfield two hundred & sixty Pounds, seven Shillings & one penny and Philip Davis seven Pounds ten Shillings specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Landale nineteen Pounds fifteen Shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit for the use of George Ainsworth per Account passed. -

Permission given to John Round Morris of Worcester County in the State of Maryland to apply to his Excellency General Washington on the Commanding Officers at the Out Posts of the American Army for leave to go into the City of New York for the purpose of endeavoring to procure the release of Collier a Prisoner -

Saturday 14 September 1782

Ordered that the western Shew Treasurer pay to Elizabeth Isabell five Pounds, one Shilling & six pence specie due her per Account passed. That the said Treasurer pay to John Small twenty pounds

specie on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Priscilla Pinkney thirty seven Pounds, ten Shillings specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed -

Whereas by the Petition of Andrew Gosh of Prichard County which is certified by a number of his neighbours Inhabitants of said County, it is represented that he was fined by a Militia Court Martial for a neglect of Militia Duty to the amount of twenty Pounds, and that he is not an able bodied man or fit for Militia Duty having had a rupture for ten years
