Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Richard Grahams sixty seven Pounds, seven shillings and six Pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State due him for a Horse furnished Les Legion per Certificate of M^r Lane adjusted -

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Clements fifty nine Pounds, ten shillings & three Pence specie agreeable to the Act aforesaid per Certificate of Joshua George adjusted -

That the Ammunition deliver to Lieut Edward Hamilton two Hundred & fifty musket Cartridges on Account of the Continent -

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to William West ten Pounds, five shillings & six Pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed -

Permission given to Major John Lynch of this State to apply to his Excellency General Washington or the Officer commanding at the Out Posts of the American Army for Leave to go into the City of New York for the purpose of transacting private Business -

Friday 20th September 1782

Ordered that John Shaw Ammunition make up such Ammunition as Captain Watley shall require for the use of the Barges -

Commission issued to Henry Woodfords appointed Ensign of Capt Bruce Gaspaway's Company in the Elk ridge Battalion of Militia in Ann Arundel County -

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to John Shaw eighty seven Pounds, fifteen shillings & eleven Pence specie out of the money appropriated for equipping & fitting out the Barges due him per Account passed -

That the said Treasurer pay to Montjoy Bayly thirty Pounds specie on Account

Saturday 21st September 1782

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Dr Charles Worthington out of the money approp. for the Barges twenty Pounds specie to purchase Medicines & Hospital Store on Account & forty five Pounds specie per Act passed -
