 over to John Thomas and the remainder eleven pounds five shillings to  
 be paid over to William Selby due them for apprehending and delivering  
 up Prisoners of War by account passed to be charged to the United States.

Permission given to Mrs. Hopkins formerly of Chester  
 Town in Kent County, but late of the City of New York, to return into this  
 State for the purpose of visiting them and to bring her wearing apparel. -

Commission issued to Richard Harwood jmt. elected Sheriff  
 of Anne Arundel County, dated 11<sup>th</sup> Instant

Ordered that the western shew Treasurer pay to Bennett  
 Anderson nine pounds fifteen shillings - William Hall eight pounds and  
 Alexander Gowan forty nine pounds sixteen shillings specie agreeable  
 to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per accounts passed. -

Commission issued to Samuel Groome Osborn elected  
 Sheriff of Harford County. -

Ordered that the western shew Treasurer pay to Charles Green  
 twenty five pounds three shillings - Thomas Hyde twenty eight pounds  
 six shillings and eight pence - Peter Beerast three hundred and four  
 pounds, fourteen shillings and seven pence - The Honorable John  
 Rogers Eight hundred and ninety eight pounds, four shillings and  
 four pence and Nicholas Cwall forty two pounds eleven shillings  
 and two pence specie agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debts due  
 from this State" per accounts and certificates adjusted & passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Mary Pringle three  
 pounds specie due her per account passed. -

Commissions issued to William McLaughlin elected  
 Sheriff of Baltimore County - John Stevens Sheriff of Dorchester County  
 and Samuel Ridgway Sheriff of Queen Anne County. -

William Goldborough and William Townson of this  
 State are appointed Ensigns in the Maryland Line, the Rank and  
 Arrangement to be settled hereafter. -

Benjamin Morgan, George Howell Leigh and Patrick  
 Carbery having been presented and fined at a County Court held for St.
