It appearing from the return of the Judges of the Election of

the names of one thousand and forty one voters - from which circumstances  
there are good grounds to suspect and this Board do adjudge that the said  
Election begun and held on Monday the 7<sup>th</sup> of this Instant, was not  
made fairly and agreeable to the Constitution of this State; and therefore  
that a new writ of Election for Sheriffs be issued agreeable to the  
directions of the Form of Government and the Act of Assembly in  
such case made and provided. —

In consequence of the above Determination of the Election for  
Sheriffs of Montgomery County a writ hath this Day issued directed to  
the Judges of the said County for retarding the same Election. —
