Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Benjamin Morgan two hundred and sixteen pounds, thirteen shillings and nine pence specie due him for surveying ~~the~~ as per Account Lodged with the Auditor. -

Permission given to Baruch Williams of Carl County to solicit His Excellency General Washington or the Officers commanding at the Out posts of the American Army for a Flag to go into the City of New York for the purpose of obtaining the Books, Records and other Public Papers belonging to Carl County aforesaid which were carried from thence in the year seventeen hundred and twenty seven by the British Army under the command of General Howe, on their passage through this State to Philadelphia. -

Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October 1782

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Joseph Middleton eleven pounds five shillings specie for transporting three Officers of the Maryland Line to the Head of Elk per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to St. George Grason thirty pounds specie out of the money appropriated for the Barges per Account passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Middleton ten pounds, two shillings and six pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Wilson twenty five pounds, eight shillings and ten pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due per Certificate adjusted the 5<sup>th</sup> Instant

Commission issued to Peter Edmondson elected Sheriff of Caroline County. -

Monday 28<sup>th</sup> October 1782

Permission is hereby given to Captain Bennett Buxey of Starford County to solicit Leave of His Excellency General Washington or the Officers commanding at the Out posts of the Army to obtain a Flag to go into New York to endeavor to get Jesse Buxey (the son of Jesse Buxey of Baltimore County who lost a limb onboard the *Matilda* and who is now confined onboard the prison ship) released from captivity and Permission is also given to Edward Parker to go with the said Captain Bennett Buxey to assist in conveying home the said Jesse Buxey in case his release should be obtained. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Lewis Gassaway Watkins twenty seven pounds, seventeen shillings and seven pence half penny - Major Benjamin Brookes twenty seven pounds and three pence and Captain John Gwilt Jones twenty pounds, two shillings, specie out of the money that came from the *Arwana*, put into the Treasury by Major General Smallwood, to be accounted for and charged to the United States. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Daniel Bryan five pounds, seventeen shillings specie out of the money appropriated for the Barges to pay for 70<sup>th</sup> rops for the use of the vessel hired
