That the said Treasurer pay to John Gibson Senr. fifty
eight pounds, eleven shillings, and six pence and John Gibson J. forty two
pounds, thirteen shillings and six pence specie agreeable to the Act aforesaid
per Certificate adjusted. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Joseph Chaplins five
hundred and twenty four pounds, four shillings and five pence half penny a-
greeable to the Act aforesaid for the use of his late Company of Select
Militia per Payrolle passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Ann Scobon, Alice Rodman
and Mary Gmolly one pound two shillings and six pence each & David
Miller three pounds, twelve shillings and eight pence specie due them
per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Nathaniel Magruder
three hundred and twenty five pounds, twelve shillings and six pence specie
for the use of Captain John Reeds Company stationed at Fredericks Town
on Account. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Captain Daniel Bryan thirty
Pounds current Money out of the Money appropriated for the Barges to be
delivered over to Captain Gedekiah Walley to be applied to the purchase
of Hospital Stores and accounted for. -

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Capt Bryan, all
the Brandy in his Possession for the use of the Barges except a thirty gallon
Hogg. -
