

Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November 1782

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Aquila Smith ten pounds five shillings and six pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed.

Commissioners issued to Abel Grace appointed first Lieut. Jonathan Gohm second Lieut. Vincent Price Ensign of Capt John Donohy's Company - William Rose second Lieut of Captain Richard Bruffs Company - Samuel Thomas Captain in the room of John Thomas jun<sup>r</sup>, Elisha Stewart first Lieutenant, Charles Walker Bemy second Lieut. - Richard Johns Capt in the room of Nathaniel Cooper, Daniel Lambden first Lieutenant and Nicholas Lovoday second Lieutenant - belonging to the fourth Battalion of Militia in Talbot County and also to William Lambden appointed Captain in the room of George Dawson, John Lowe first Lieut, William Sears second Lieut - Richard Harrington first Lieut, Richard Hart second Lieut and John Ray Enf. of Capt Charles Gardiner's Company belonging to the thirty eighth Battalion of Militia in the said County. -

Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> November 1782

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to George Barber who was taken in the State Boat Docthm Capt Madleton fifty seven pounds ten shillings specie due him as Steward of said Boat per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieutenants Nicholas Ricketts and John Chew of the Artillery, each, ten pounds specie to be by them accounted for. -

Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 1782

Ordered that the Commissary of Provisions deliver to John A Stone Esquire five hundred Bushels of Wheat at Baltimore Town on the Head of Elk on Account of his Salary -

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Col<sup>o</sup> Samuel Smith fifty Pounds, and one penny specie for Squabigs purchased by Will<sup>m</sup> Baggett of Prince Georges County, eight pounds, four shillings and four pence specie for Provision seized by John S. Brooker & also one hundred and fifty seven pounds, eight shillings specie due him per Act adjusted & passed. -

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> November 1782

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to James Meale seven pounds six shillings and nine pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Wailoney for the use of Stephen Steward thirty one Pounds specie on Account.

That the Commissary of Provisions deliver to James Buel six hundred and fifty six Bushels and two thirds of a Bushel of Wheat and Alexander Conlee Hanian Esquire two hundred and four and an half Bushels of Wheat at Baltimore Town on the Head of Elk on Account of their Salaries. -
