

Ordered that the Commissary of Provisions deliver to Colo. Nathaniel Ramsey for the use of the Commissioners for the preservation and Sale of Confiscated British Property, three thousand Bushels of Wheat at Baltimore Town or the Head of Elk on account of their Commissions. -

Friday 8th November 1702

Ordered that the Commissary of Provisions deliver to His Excellency Thomas Sim Lee Esquire six hundred and sixty six Bushels and two thirds of a Bushel of Wheat at Baltimore Town or the Head of Elk on account of his Salary. -

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Dorsey Wheeler of the twenty thousand pounds appropriated for the Payment of Creditors of a particular description due them on a Certificate issued agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State.

That the said Treasurer pay to Brice J. B. Worthington Esq. ten pounds, one shilling and eight pence - and Truby Treloar twenty one Pounds, seventeen shillings specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Accounts passed. -

Saturday 9th November 1702

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Doct. James Murray two hundred and fifty pounds Current Money for Medicines &c supplied the Hospital to be by him Accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to Archibald Gordon eighty three pounds Current money due him on Account passed. -

Monday 11th November 1702

Commission issued to James Jones appointed Ensign of Captain Lewis Kirkmans Company in the Upper Battalion of Militia in Dorchester County. -

Commission issued to John M. Nicholls elected Sheriff of Montgomery County. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Samuel Mark twenty pounds, sixteen shillings and four pence specie for a Horse purchased by A. M. Lane for Col. Lees Corps agreeable to a Resolve of the Assembly of December 1st 1700 per Certificate adjusted and passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to David Poe one hundred and twenty one pounds, fourteen shillings specie to be charged to the United States per Account passed. -

That the Commissary of Provisions deliver to Tho. Gaspaway two hundred and sixty six Bushels and two thirds of a Bushel of Wheat at Baltimore Town or the Head of Elk on account of his Salary. -

Tuesday 12th November 1702
