

Ordered That the Commissary of Provisions deliver to William Hyde one hundred and fifteen Bushels and an Half of a Bushel of Wheat at Baltimore Town on the Head of Elk on Account of his Salary -

Wednesday 13th of November 1782

Ordered that the Commissary of Provisions deliver to Rob^t Johnson just two hundred Bushels of Wheat at Baltimore Town on the Head of Elk on Account of his Salary. -

Thursday 14th of November 1782

Ordered that the Spring Commissary deliver to Mr Paul Snyder Provisions for four persons thirty Days agreeable to an Order of the Secretary at War of the 15th of January 1782

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Henry Hooper thirty four Pounds, ten shillings specie due him per Account passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Hellen one Pound two Shillings and six pence specie for transporting three Soldiers from Baltimore per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Townend eighteen Pounds specie due him per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to David McMathew for the use of Alexander Donaldson nineteen Pounds, three Shillings and seven pence specie out of the twenty thousand Pounds appropriated for the Payment of Creditors of a particular description, for Money lent in May 1780 per Certificate adjusted & passed. -

Commission of Letters of Marque and Reprisal issued to Henry White Commander of the Schooner Havana eighty Tons burthen navigated by twelve men mounting five carriage Guns, belonging to Thomas Worthington and Thomas Yates of Baltimore dated 25th October 1782. -
