

Friday 22nd November 1702.

Present as on Yesterday

Jeremiah Townly Esquire a Member of the Council attended produced a certificate of his Qualification and took his Seat. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to William Stevenson Esquire twenty four Pounds, five Shillings specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State eight pounds, thirteen Shillings and four pence for the use of Nathaniel Baint, eight pounds one Shilling, and eight pence for the use of James Woodward and seven pounds ten Shillings for the use of Benjamin Kennard due them on Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Nicholls, two hundred and sixty four pounds, eight Shillings and one penny specie agreeable to the Act aforesaid due him, on his Certificate adjusted and passed the 4th Instant.

Commission issued to Henry Shryock elected Sheriff of Washington County. -

Commission of Letters of Marque and Reprisal issued to William Thomas Commander of the Schooner Freeman one hundred and four one burthen, navigated with twenty one men mounting six Carriages Arms, belonging to Charles Cookshanks and Company of Maryland dated the 25th of October 1702. -

Samuel Chan Esquire a Member of the House of Delegates waits on the Council with an Order of the House signifying the Opinion of the General Assembly that the Election of the Governor be notified to the Citizens of this State by Proclamation issued to the Sheriffs of the several Counties to be by them published, by the Sheriff of Ann Arundel on this Day and by the Sheriffs of the other Counties on the 14th Day of next Month. The Council thereupon direct the Sheriffs to make Proclamation accordingly. -

His Excellency William Paca Esquire having this Day been Qualified in the Senate House in the Presence of this Member of the General Assembly, took his Seat in the Council. -

Saturday 23rd November 1702

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Rejm Beall two hundred and forty seven pounds, sixteen Shillings and one penny and Capt Thomas Beall forty seven pounds, fourteen Shillings specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Accounts Certificates adjusted and passed. -

Monday 25th November 1702

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Nath^{aniel} Smith sixteen pounds twelve Shillings specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from
