Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Joseph Gilpin four hundred and sixty two pounds, four shillings and ten pence. John D. Thompson thirty two pounds, four shillings and six pence. Baruch Williams thirty one pounds five shillings and seven pence. Samuel Hughes seven pounds, three shillings and four pence. and Benjamin Miller Ten pounds, fifteen shillings and two pence specie agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per Certificates adjusted and passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Darnall forty eight pounds eighteen shillings specie agreeable to the Act aforesaid due him on a Certificate for a Horse purchased 16th June 1701 with Interest to this Day. -
